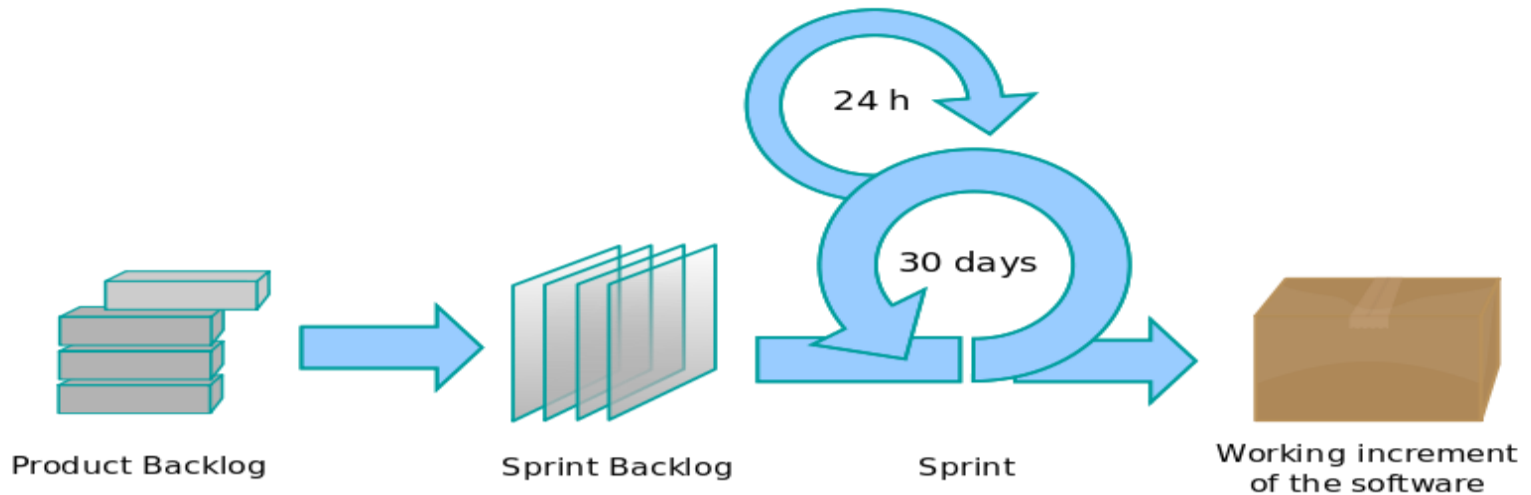

Eligibility Criteria

An (PMI-ACP)[®] candidate must fulfill certain educational and professional experience to be eligible for the (PMI-ACP)[®] exam as put forwarded by the Project Management Institute (PMI[®], USA)

Educational Background: Secondary degree (high school diploma, associate's degree or global equivalent)

General Project Experience: 2,000 hours (12 months) of experience working on project teams during the last 5 years.

Agile Project Experience: 1,500 hours (8 months) of experience working on agile project teams during last three years. These hours are in addition to the 2,000 hours required in general project experience.

Training in Agile Practices: 21 contact hours must be earned in agile project management topics.

Note: For those holding a PMP[®] credential, PMI[®] has already verified that the candidate has exceeded these requirements. Thus, a PMP[®] will be - accepted to fulfill these requirements.
